I was born on 7 July 1986.

I attended primary school and the building. I too was on the average maturity of the school

(I, II, "Life in Abundance" I have a disability in the two lower leg limbs with a disability rating of 100%.)

My birth was normal, and up to my 4th Year I was healthy and happy. With 5 years ago, I contracted polio, which lasted a long time. Thus, I was idle for many years and could not get it.

With 9 years, I had even an accident. I fell off a wall and broke my left leg here. Here are 3 views I give;

In 1998, I began to learn, starting at the level of the 3rd class.

Then I went to school very late, I had lots of advice from my mother hear and accept help. They always told me that I have much to learn, no matter what difficulties may arise and they also told me that you can only get respect through knowledge of other people. Since I have the disability in the lower legs would be the only way to make it in life, something to make the conclusion.

Life was never easy, neither for myself nor for my brothers and sisters because my parents never had the financial means to come for my training and my siblings, for expression.

My father has never been able to help me during my education because my father always had problems with alcohol. My mother always had to sell something to our daily life, to deny. Thus, they had no time to help me learn.
But I never forgot her advice, despite the many difficulties.

In 1999, I learned my first basic skills in English. Language. My parents knew nothing about it because the school was further away and the classes took place in the evening. I also knew that they would not let me learn. Mainly my mother would have been against it.

At school it was becoming increasingly difficult. At every class change increased the costs. So my older brother left because of the financial burden on the school.

2003, when I was in 7th grade, the situation changed. I felt that I could fulfill the desire of my mother, who was that I should learn to get a degree and in life should be something.

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This year, I met someone whom I describe as a true gift from God and made me believe that my dreams could come true if one believes in it, only fixed.

Ms Rhonda, which for me is like a mother, because everything she does and did, only a mother can do for a son. I'm going to her my whole life to be grateful. No matter where they may be, God will always illuminate their path and they will always be a part of my history.

In 2005 I started with the medium maturity, which was very stressful for me but I knew I had to win this fight.

Year after year, I exerted myself to hard to make progress and to progress to the next class. I had the goal of this school with success from close but 31 January 2008, something unexpected happened to me. I became very strong for 5 months.

During this time I thought that it would now be the end for me and everything I have planned, changed into the impossible. My conclusion, the dreams of my mother, I thought this would all be over now.

Fortunately, I recovered from this disease again and returned to learning.

The year 2008 was a year marked by many problems. It was a year of crises and disease but still I was determined my goal to make the conclusion sought. What I managed with much effort.

In 2009 I had another goal in mind, because I realized I could not now stop. This objective was, I was writing in the university too, which was very difficult for me because the number of free places was very limited. But since I had nothing to lose, I enrolled in any subject and prepared me for my home in front of the entrance examination. Thank God I was added.

At the time I visit, the change 1st year in computer science.

I am aware that my duties will now increase and needs to study with them my problems but I do because this is the only way to thank the people who always supported me. As Ms Rhonda, Luis Alberto and my mother.

It is still a long way I have to go but my disability is not a compelling reason to stop me in my progression to my spirit is healthy and ready to do everything that my limbs are not able to do for me.
